2024 was an incredible year, and we give all glory to God! This year, we tripled the number of survivors we served, providing hope, healing, and restoration like never before.

Many of you know that we began the year by purchasing the old Deja Vu strip club, transforming it into what will soon be the Freedom Center—a place of healing!

We had the opportunity for full funding from the city of Spokane Valley, but accepting it would have meant the building could be used for secular use only. Instead, we turned down the opportunity for the one million dollar grant, turned the open shower into a baptismal, and have spent the past year holding revival services inside the former strip club—where we've seen hundreds come to Christ!

It's no coincidence that Spokane, the birthplace of Father's Day, is also the city where God is restoring His daughters—turning a "gentlemen's club" into a place of true healing.

Today, we are making a greater impact than ever in the fight against human trafficking, and it's all because of your support. We can't wait to see what God will do in 2025!


